What is Seattle Children’s Hospital? Seattle Children’s Hospital was formed in 1907 to serve the children of the Pacific Northwest region “regardless of their family’s ability to pay”, that mission remains their central focus today. In the last fiscal year, Children’s provided over 111 million dollars in uncompensated care for families from the Northwest whose children need specialized treatment and care. Seattle Children’s was ranked by U.S. News and World Report as the 5th best children’s hospital in the nation with the Seattle Children’s Research Center ranked 3rd nationwide.

What is the Pacific Northwest Karting Challenge? The Karting Challenge is a 2-hour team race, held at PGP Motorsports Track at Pacific Raceways in Kent, WA, to raise money for Seattle Children’s Hospital. It will consist of a maximum of 25 teams of 4 qualified drivers. The teams are selected on a “first to register and send in their registration fee basis”. Team spots will not be held without payment of registration fee. Each team is expected to complete 60-70 laps in 2 hours on the 14-turn Pacific Grand Prix circuit and raise a minimum of \$500 for Children’s Hospital. This year’s Karting Challenge will be held on June 16, 2017.

What other events does the SOVREN Guild produce to help Children’s? The Pacific Northwest Historics is a three-day race sanctioned by SOVREN (Society of Vintage Racing Enthusiasts). In our 25 year history, we have raised over 10 million dollars for Seattle Children’s Hospital. This year’s Historics will be held June 30 – July 2, 2017. Qualifications: 1. Hold a valid competitors license in any sanctioned motorsport event 2. Attend a practice day and drive within 115% of an established time for given track configuration 3. Compete in one of the 4-wheeled disciplines at PGP and show a level of driving competence and safety. Contact Scott at PGP for details at (253) 639-7223.

Minimum Requirements: 5’ tall and must wear long pants, long-sleeved shirt and closed-toe shoes. Helmets are covered in registration fee and coveralls are available. **Each driver must “qualify” for the race;** details above and online at www.northwesthistorics.com or www.pacificcgp.com.
