TICKET PRICES: Adults 3 Day Event Ticket: \$25, Children age 7-16: \$5 per day, Children 6 years and under are free, Seniors 65 years and up 3 Day Event Ticket \$15, Military and first responders with ID \$10 for event weekend. Tickets may be purchased in person at track ticket booth. Handicap parking is available up front by the ticket entrance. Online ticket sales may be purchased at northwesthistorics.com. Please bring receipt of purchase to the ticket booth to receive your prepaid tickets.

EVENT DISCRIPTION: The Pacific Northwest Historics features many of the world's rarest and most beautiful pre-1997- race cars. For 2023 is the 35th Anniversary of the Pacific Northwest Historic Races. This event will be celebrating 120 Years Ford and the 48th Anniversary of the Shelby American Automobile Club Shelby. There will be some significant Shelby cars on display from the club. Cobra, Mustang, along with your other favorite cars racing GT40, BMW, Porsche, Camaro, Alfa Romeo, Corvette, Lotus, Lola, MG, Datsun and many more. These cars come from all over the West Coast and Canada. The track is 2.25 miles with a 300-foot elevation drop and nearly a ¾ mile straightaway. There is infield access to cross over and watch the races at the ticket gate. You will be able to see the cars up close in their paddocks and meet the drivers.

SPECIAL RACES: 2nd Annual Emerald Cup, featuring all Formula Fords will be featured on Saturday July 1st in the afternoon.
5th Annual Sprite & Midget Challenge will be featured on Friday June 30th in the afternoon.

GUEST CELEBRITY: Mr. Steve Saleen, founder of Saleen Autosport/Saleen, Inc. and a few others, which is an OEM manufacturer of Saleen S1, Saleen S7 and highly modified Ford Mustang in 1983. He started his professional racing career in 1980 with Formula Atlantic. He also raced the SCCA Trans-Am Series in 1982 driving a Ford Mustang, also raced IndyCar/Cart in 1989, and 24 Hours of Le Mans in 1997. In 1996 Steve was inducted into the Mustang Hall of Fame along with Carroll Shelby. In March to celebrate 40th Anniversary he unveiled his SA-40 Mustang Speedster Anniversary Special with 800 HP.
